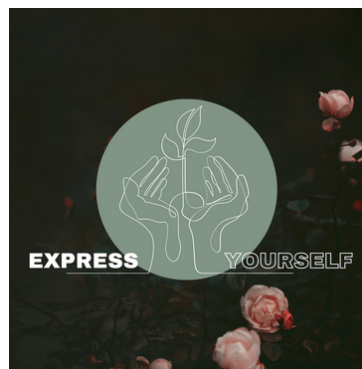




# LISA MEINERS' TOPICS
